MINUTES

General Meeting – January 19, 2016

A quorum being present the meeting was called to order at 8 PM in the main hall of Post 201 by *Commander Dennis Turner*. He presented three new members and five transfers for membership – *Harry Davis, Michael Thifault, Robert Smith, Francisco Perez, Jim Velcheck, Robert Ottesen, Derek Smith and William Goin.* All were approved unanimously as were 17 transfers-in from Roswell Post 319 which is disbanding.

Public Relations – *Past Commander Marty Farrell* reported that planning for this year's Old Soldiers Day has begun in earnest. There will be a planning meeting January 20th.
