General Membership Meet Scheduled For 7 p.m. Tuesday. Dinner at 6 p.m.

February's General Membership meeting is scheduled for 7 p.m. Tuesday with dinner being served starting in the 6 p.m. time frame. Although an agenda was not available by this issue's publication deadline, based on reports at this past Tuesday's executive committee meeting there are no "hot button" issues requiring a membership vote at the membership meeting.

Post Commander Fred Mahony said that the District 9 Commander Gary S. Ely is scheduled to attend the membership meeting. The menu for dinner prior to the meeting will be sliced pork, mashed potatoes, vegetable and salad, according Paul Sheridan

The Post's recent oratorical contest winner, Vinayak Menon, 18, who is a student at Forsyth County's Lambert High School, is scheduled to deliver his winning 10-minute speech at the meeting. His presentation, "The U.S. Constitution - - The Compass to a More Perfect Union" earned him a \$1,000 scholarship check from the Post.

Other Post-related news highlights from the executive committee meeting included:

- - Status updates on various projects around the post that are assigned to the House Committee.
- - Repairs on the baseball concession stand are nearing completion. As expected, most of the delay now centers around parts on order to complete the work.
- - The concession stand is open for King's Ridge games. It is manned by members of the legion family.
- - Laughter at the Legion attracted 103 paid attendees and cleared, after expenses, \$761.52 for the evening. There may be some minor accounting adjustments to the number to reflect bar sales in the clubroom to 'Laughter' attendees even though service was available in the ballroom prior to and after the event.

Also, the Finance Committee reported that the Post's W-2 salaries for calendar year 2022 were \$106,365.36 compared to 2021 which was \$79,166.78 and Form 1099 expenses for 2022 were \$51,052.00 compared to 2021 which was \$56,346.98.

- - Discussions are underway with a local company to repair or replace the flagpole in the center ring of flags at the front door. The Post has not been able to fly the U.S. Flag on that pole for more than two months because the pulley wheel at the top of the pole is broken.
- - The Baseball Committee is aggressively pursuing \$20,000 to repair seats at the field. The membership has approved \$5,000 in Post funds to support the project on the assumption that the addition funds can raised from community sources.

- - Sunday night's Super Bowl LVII pot luck dinner attracted some 30+ members and friends for the evening, a good turnout by Post 201 standards.
