'Submarine Mike' Kotler's Memorial Services, Burial Set for Tomorrow

Memorial services for 12-year American Legion and Post 201 member "Submarine Mike" Kotler are scheduled for 11:30 a.m. tomorrow (Wednesday, Feb.22) at Dignity Memorial's Roswell Funeral Home, 950 Mansell Road. Burial will follow at 2 p.m. at Georgia National Cemetery, 2025 Mount Carmel Church Lane, Canton.

In addition to his Legion membership, the U.S. Navy and Viet Nam veteran was also a member of the Johns Creek Veterans Association, Vet Buds, VFW Post #12002, and Grayback Base Atlanta, a U.S. submarine veterans organization.

Director & Chairman of the Board of the Georgia Military Veterans' Hall of Fame (GMVHOF) Col. Richard H. White, U. S. Army (Ret.) said Mike, "was a great supporter of the GMVHOF."

"He was the most prolific nominator of candidates for the GMVHOF," White said noting that of the 17 nominations Mike submitted, nine were inducted - - - a record that no one has matched to date. White also described Mike as "the epitome of 'The Selfless Servant'."
