American Legion Commander ID's 2023 National Legislative Priorities

Speaking at the opening session of the Legion's 2023 Washington Conference Commanders Call on Feb. 28, National Commander, Vincent J. "Jim" Troiola, outlined the organization's major legislative priorities for the first session of the 118th Congress. He also thanked the 117th Congress for their support of the PACT Act, which will allow more than 3.5 million toxic-exposed veterans to be eligible for VA benefits.

The Legion's 2023 legislative priorities include:

- - Protect and improve the GI Bill. Reservists and National Guardsmen often cannot take advantage of all the benefits in the existing legislation.

- - Respect the U.S. flag and allow Congress to once again claim the right to protect the flag from desecration.

- - Protect veterans from predatory actors such as law firms that are overcharging veterans after they had already been exposed to contaminated drinking water.

- - Advocate for citizenship for military service.

- - Ensure that the U.S. Coast Guard is paid during any future government shutdowns.

"We must remind our senators, representatives and their staff that they have no higher calling than the care and well-being of our veterans, our active military and their families," Troiola also said during his remarks.
