Leadership Nominations, \$\$ Expenditures On Tuesday's Membership Meet Agenda

April's General Membership meeting, scheduled for 7 p.m. Tuesday, is shaping up to be a busy one for members. In addition to nominating officers and one executive committee member for leadership positions next year, there are several matters involving major expenditures needing member approval.

And for those who always ask, "Yes" dinner will be served prior to the meeting starting in the 6 p.m. time frame. This month's menu will be an assortment of pizza offerings.

At the meeting membership approvals are expected to be sought for:

- \$2,000 to support the upcoming Family Day at the Legion on Saturday, Apr. 29.

- \$1,350 to complete the flooring in the Clubroom/Bar area.

- \$1,533.71 to purchase a new beer tub for the Clubroom/Bar. The current one has been leaking for at least a year.

- \$500 to purchase fertilizer for the Walk of Memories Grounds.

- \$150 to bring the already approved \$350 donation to the "Submarine" Mike Kotler Scholarship up to \$500. This would be the Post's contribution to fund an anticipated \$4,000 scholarship in his memory. His VFW Post (which meets at Post 201) has committed \$2,000 toward the goal and the Johns Creek Veterans Association anticipates making up the difference to bring the scholarship to the \$4,000 goal.

The scholarship in Mike's name would be presented by the Georgia Military Veterans Hall of Fame to a JROTC high school senior who plans to attend a university or college in Georgia, continue to participate in ROTC and accept a commission upon graduation.

In addition to the financial expenditures discussion, other agenda items may include the upcoming June 10 "Laughter at the Legion" program, current plans to start an "Old Glory" raffle in the Clubroom, an update on the status of Bingo, and additional construction needed at the baseball field concession stand.

Leadership Nominations

The evening's key activity is expected to be the nominations for next year's leadership.

Adjutant Tom Billings has posted a nomination form on the bulletin board in the Clubroom for write-in nominations for five officer and one member of the executive committee for the 2023–2024 year.

Additional nominations may be made from the floor during Tuesday's meeting, after which nominations will be closed. This will give those nominated approximately one month to solicit support and encourage supporters of candidates nominated to attend the Tuesday, May 16 General Membership meeting - - - at which time next year's leadership will be elected.

The open officer positions for one-year terms include: Commander, Senior Vice Commander, Junior Vice Commander, Finance Officer, and Judge Advocate. Also one Executive Committee member slot is open which is a three-year term.

At publication deadline yesterday here are the published nominations. - Three for Commander: Jeff Rahn, nominated by Calvin Bennett; Dave Kirchner, nominated by Jim Nessia; and Tom Billings nominated by Fred Mahony.

- None for Sr. Vice Commander.
- One for Jr. Vice Commander: Tom Richardson who is self nominated.
- One for Finance Officer: Ralph Jordan, nominated by Dave Kirchner.
- None for Judge Advocate.
- None for the three-year executive committee position.

Billings says the position of Commander, which according to the Post By-Laws is normally a two year term, will be a for a one-year term this year in order to complete the unexpired term of Fred Mahony, the current Post Commander. Mahony has said he will not serve the second year of his term due to personal plans which will be taking him away from the local area.

To be a candidate or to nominate a candidate, and to vote in the election you must be a Post 201 Legionnaire in good standing and paid up for Calendar Year 2023. Billings also said that nominees must provide a copy of their DD-214 to be certified as eligible by the Credentials Committee prior to the election.
