32-Day, 20,000-Mile March to Honor Vets, Service Members Starts Today

Starting today and through May 29, the Department of Veterans Affairs will support a 20,000-mile march with more than 214,000 volunteers in honor of veterans and service members.

This is an annual collaboration between VA's National Cemetery Administration and Carry The Load, a non-profit organization that provides active ways to connect Americans to the sacrifices made daily by military, veterans, first responders, and their families.

The Relay travel routes cover all continental 48 states, ending with the Dallas,, Tex. Memorial March. The five routes (West Coast, Mountain States, Midwest, New England, and East Coast), and teams walk and cycle throughout the 32-day Memorial May campaign.

Events in Georgia are scheduled between Tuesday, May 16 and Friday, May 19. They are part of the "New England" route. <u>Click here</u> and scroll to the May 16 – May 19 dates for a complete list of events at each the 27 Georgia location including metro activities in Gwinnett, DeKalb, Cobb counties and the City of Atlanta. No events are planned in the North Fulton area.

Those who wish to participate in a march are asked to <u>register with Carry The Load in advance</u>. No donation is required to participate. Carry the Load was founded in 2011 as a grassroots effort by two veteran U.S. Navy SEALs. Since that time it has grown into a nationwide movement with people volunteering throughout the year to honor and remember our nation's heroes.
