# **Executive Committee OK's \$20K**For Replacement Kitchen Hood

At Tuesday evening's Executive Committee meeting, the long-discussed 'kitchen hood matter' finally moved toward a final resolution with an approval to spend up to \$20,000 to purchase and install a new, larger hood over the kitchen stove.

The hood itself is expected to cost some \$6,000. The difference includes \$9,600 to install it and another \$4,000 to install a new fire suppression system that meets code enforcement standards associated with the new hood.

The installation will be done by Larry Mathis, owner of Superior Repair Service. The new hood and associated fixtures are being manufactured by Hoodmart, who has operations in Dallas (Ga.). The need for a new hood was identified last year during a routine code inspection by the Alpharetta Fire Marshall's office.

When the work is completed, the Post can start renting the kitchen again to third parties who need it for their specific cooking or food related functions, or in conjunction with rentals of the Post's ballroom where access to an industrial kitchen is needed as part of the rental package request.

Other highlights of Tuesday's Executive Committee meeting include:

- Approved spending approximately \$1,600 to purchase a small freezer, a table-top
  warmer and a popcorn machine for the concession stand. Reimbursement for this
  expenditure is expected to come from concession stand sales during the remainder of
  the baseball season.
- Heard an update on the FY 2023-2024 budget which is currently being developed.
   Finance officer Ralph Jordan said he expects the final budget would be presented to Post membership for approval at the July membership meeting.

Current projections assume total income for the year (before expenses) to be in the range of half a million dollars. Expense projections are in the same general range suggesting a need for continued expense monitoring during the coming year. More work and "drilling down" on individual income and expense budget lines will be taking place during the next 2-3 weeks.

- Although no start date has been identified, the Auxiliary is moving forward to get Bingo restarted at the Post. Equipment is currently being tested and some test games will be played before a "Bingo is Back" date can be announced.
- New flooring is expected to be installed in the Clubroom starting Sunday night, May 21 with installation completed before the Clubroom is scheduled to be open at 3 p.m. Monday, May 22. The pool table, which will need to be removed from the Clubroom during the floor install, is scheduled to be returned to the Clubroom on Tuesday, May 23. Volunteers are needed to help with the floor install on May 22 starting at 7 a.m. and throughout the day.

Most of the volunteer help is needed first thing in the morning to move furniture out of the Clubroom - - - then as work is completed to move the furniture back in. Also some late Sunday night moving help is needed to move some items so the install work can get a good jumpstart Monday morning. Email Bob Byrd at bobbyrd947@gmail.com if you can help.

- Adjutant Tom Billings provided an update on how Leadership elections would be handled at the upcoming General Membership meeting this coming Tuesday. (Editor's Note: A special election edition of this newsletter will be published tomorrow.)
