23-24 Leadership Steps Up to the Plate Today; Former Adjutant Tom Billings Now Commander

Post 201's leadership responsibility for the next 12 months now belongs to the recently elected leadership team, effective this morning.

The team includes: Commander – Tom Billings; Immediate Past Commander – Fred Mahony; Adjutant – Harry Hollingsworth; Sr. Vice Commander – Alan Dudley; Jr. Vice Commander – Tom Richardson; Finance Officer – Ralph Jordan; Judge Advocate – Bob Byrd; and Executive Committee Members Bob Moye (3 year term), Mike Roman (2 year term), and an open position to fill the remaining 1 year term formally held by Bob Byrd.

The executive committee will fill the open position.

Open Letter to Post Membership

In an open letter to the membership that he asked to be distributed via this publication Billings wrote:

"Thank you for trusting me to be your Commander for the next year. I'll strive to live up to that trust and not disappoint. Post 201 has successfully emerged from the "Era of Covid" in sound financial condition thanks to the leadership of Past Commanders Fred Mahony and Alan Dudley as well as the continued efforts of many Legionnaires.

"Now it's time for us to focus on the traditional American Legion values, i.e. the four pillars of service - 1. Veterans Affairs & Rehabilitation, 2. National Security, 3. Americanism, and 4. Children & Youth. Ways to expand our emergency assistance and educational assistance to veterans should be explored.

"Sending young men to Boy's State and helping the Auxiliary send young women to Girls State to learn about the functioning of our government should be a priority. Engaging with the community such as with Law Officers and First Responders would benefit everyone.

"Post operations are extensive. We have the club room and bar open every day except for Christmas and Thanksgiving, dances several days and evenings per week, hall rental for various events, and a

robust baseball field utilization and concession operation. The Walk of Memories and maintenance of our 13-acre campus all require the effort of many.

"Both financial and physical resources are necessary for the operation of the post. We have an active finance committee and a forward-looking Finance Officer scrutinizing our finances, but please consider volunteering to help with the physical needs.

"Along with the support of the Sons of the Legion and the Auxiliary we are the Legion Family. Together let's continue to make Post 201 the premier post in Georgia. Please email me at tombill03@comcast.net with your suggestions or concerns."

Billings was Post Adjutant for Five Years

Billings, who served as Post Adjutant for the past five years, retired from the U.S. Navy Reserve as a Chief Warrant Officer 4 in 1997. His naval career includes 12 years enlisted service, rising to the rank of E-7; and 20 years commissioned service.

He served with the Naval Security Group and Amphibious Group 2 during which he had assignments in Germany, Washington, D.C., National Security Agency, Charleston, Homestead, Key West, Mayport, Little Creek, and the U.S.S. Guam.

His civilian career includes 37 years as a civil engineer with the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, retiring in January 2006. During that time he earned the Army Achievement Medal for Civilian Service; the Army Achievement Medal for his leadership during Hurricane Andrew relief efforts; and two Commander's Awards for leadership in many environmental programs including Superfund, Brownfields, Installation Restoration, and BRAC programs.
