Laughter at the Legion

More than 125 tickets have been sold for Saturday night's *Laughter at the Legion* by 12 noon yesterday.

Tier 1 General Admission is \$35 and includes one free alcoholic drink (well brand or beer). Tier 2 General Admission is \$25 and does not include a free drink.

Lace Larrabee, a nationally-touring stand-up comedian and former southern beauty queen, returns to the Post for her second 'Laughter' night. Many know her as a season 17 semifinalist on America's Got Talent. She was brought back at the finale show to roast judge Simon Cowell alongside the Roastmaster General Jeff Ross.
