FY 23-24 Budget, Comedy Show Votes On Agenda for Tuesday Membership Meet

Members of the Post will be asked to vote on two significant matters at next Tuesday night's General Membership meeting. They are the FY 23-24 Budget for the Post and a proposal to schedule a comedy show at the Post on Saturday night, Sept. 30.
