2-Day District 9 'Revitalization' Starts Tomorrow at Post 201

The Department of Georgia's District 9 "Revitalization" kicks off at 9 a.m. tomorrow morning in the Post's Ballroom. This two-day event concludes at 4 p.m. Saturday afternoon.

Attendees will be able to visit with American Legion staff members to discuss veterans' benefits, VA benefits, renewing their 2024 memberships, and other associated training opportunities. A department veteran service officer will also be available to assist area veterans with claims or other veteran benefit-related questions. An attorney who practices veterans law will also be available.

District 9 Commander Gary Ely said this two-day event at the Post reflects the Legion's "focus on community service and assistance to veterans."
