FY 23-24 Budget Approved by Membership; Auxiliary Scholarship Winner Highlights Meeting

It was a close call, but one member more than the required 18 needed to conduct business attended the General Membership meeting this past Tuesday night. But it literally took getting two of them 'out of the kitchen' where they were doing repair work, in order to bring the participation up to 19, and also which resulted in a unanimous vote to adopt an FY 23-24 budget for the Post.

While the budget vote was the most important item on the Tuesday evening's agenda, perhaps the most enjoyable and unique item on the agenda (at least for most membership meetings) was listening to this year's Auxiliary scholarship winner, Sara Lewis', rendition of Lee Greenwood's God Bless the USA.

It's been nearly 40 years since Greenwood wrote what has become his signature patriotic anthem. Other significant reports presented during the meeting included:

An opportunity for military and veteran's families to have a no-cost weekend on Oct. 7 & 8 at YMCA Camp High Harbour at Lake Allatoona. The weekend is made possible through the Brittany & Kayla Memorial Fund, which was created in memory of two beloved camp staff members who had a passion for serving others. The kitchen hood is scheduled to be installed today. However, there is a delay in installing the fire suppression system, so the new completion date now appears to be mid September.

Dog droppings are causing problems in the Walk of Memories (WOM) area. Discussions are underway to post "nicely worded signs" which would say no dogs (leashed or unleashed) are allowed in the WOM area or in the concession stand area. Lots of area residents walk their animals on Post property and most do 'clean up duty' behind their animals. But the dropping problems seem to be getting progressively worse. Three new round high-top tables and chairs for each table now grace the Clubroom/Bar thanks to an anonymous donor.

The TrackMan radar system at the baseball field has been installed, but some additional work is needed for it to perform effectively.

This year's Post 201 Oratorical Contest winner, Lambert High School graduate Vinayak Menon, recently served as the captain of the 12-member 2022-23 USA Debate Team at the World Schools Debating Championships. He and his team won the first-place trophy during the week-long competition held this year in Hanoi, Vietnam. The USA victory was the first time a team from the USA won a first place trophy since 1994.

In the American Legion contest, Vinayak also won a district competition, but unfortunately did not advance beyond the area-level competition. However, at the recent World Schools Debating Championship, he was ranked among the top 10 percent of speakers in the world.
