'Kabul 13' Remembrance Ceremony At Newtown Park Veterans Memorial Walk Scheduled for 9:30 a.m. Saturday

John's Creek Veterans Association (JCVA) will host a special Memorial Dedication & Kabul 13 Remembrance Ceremony starting at 9:30 a.m. Saturday at the Veterans Memorial Walk in Newtown Park.

The ceremony commemorates the second anniversary of the bombing of the Abbey Gate of Hamid Karzai International Airport in Kabul which took the lives of 13 U.S. service members and 163 US Afghan allies and civilians seeking safety behind those very soldiers while fleeing from the Taliban.

A welcome and gathering at 9:30 a.m. will start the ceremony. This will be followed at 10 a.m. by the formal opening lead by Fr. Joseph T. O'Callahan of the Knights of Columbus Assembly 3441. That will be followed by the "Toast to the Fallen" made by guest of honor, Daniel "Santa6" Stinson.

Stinson, who was on the ground in Kabul just before the bombing, was a leader of the Veteran volunteer team which was instrumental in the evacuation of over 15,000 Afghan Allies and their families into the UAE.

"The US service men and women I saw and spoke with at Abbey Gate were the epitome of what is best in America during crisis - stalwart, honorable, compassionate, and brave service to those in need," said Stinson. "Their sense of duty, of pride, of honor was evident in each of them."

When he responded to the invitation to participate Stinson said, "I recall walking back from Abbey Gate through the checkpoints when a small pickup truck loaded down with Marines was heading to that gate with 3 or 4 female Marines on the tailgate. Their boots dangling, dirt and sand covered, but laughing and joking with one another as they rode towards just another shift. We as Veterans, and all Americans, must never forget to 'Say Their Names' out loud and with great pride and genuine gratitude so their service and sacrifice will always be remembered," he added.

"It is a great honor to the mission of our Johns Creek Association & Veterans Memorial Walk to welcome "Santa6 Actual" to share his personal experiences on the ground in Kabul in the days leading up to this tragic event before boarding one of their C-17 Globemaster III Evac flights just before that fateful day", said JCVA President and retired Army LTC Michael E Mizell.

“This will be a moving and memorable event and this year’s Ceremony keeps true our promise last year to the families of the Kabul 13 that their names will be remembered in kind, each and every year going forward,” Mizell added.

The ceremony will conclude with lunch and refreshments, then guided tours of Johns Creek Veterans Memorial Walk. Fulton County Says Post 201 No Longer Needed as Voting Site

The Post was notified yesterday that its ballroom facilities are no longer needed as a Fulton County polling location. In an email to the Post, Elections Equipment Manager Corey Henson said that “serving as a Fulton County Election Day Polling Site (has) provided an impactful contribution to our department and the citizens of Fulton.”

However, he said the Post was dropped as a polling location based on research “conducted regarding Election Day voter turnout to determine possible precinct mergers to streamline our election processes. Due to the reduction in our voting precincts, your location will no longer be required as a polling site,” he wrote in his email notification.

He said the Election Commission would place appropriate signage to guide voters to their new polling locations at visible entry points (to the Post) during the upcoming election cycle. He also said the elections staff will ensure the placement and retrieval of all signage following the 2023 Municipal General Election and Runoff.

But just in case, he did leave the door open to the future writing, “If circumstances change and our need for additional polling locations increases, we would like the opportunity to revisit or resume utilization of your location with the proper/reasonable reservation protocol as needed.”
