## E-Mail Sent to Post Members ID'd as 'Scam' Found to be Georgia Department Fundraiser

With all due respect to Paul Harvey and his 33-year long ABC Radio broadcast titled "The Rest of the Story" there is more to the "E-Mail Scam" notification readers of this publication received in the 11:20 a.m. time frame Tuesday morning.

Within an hour and 10 minutes after the Post's e-newsletter started landing in readers' inboxes, District 9 Commander Gary Ely posted an email to about 50 members of the District 9 leadership circle stating that the email campaign "... is not spam. It was intended to raise money for the DOG (Department of Georgia)."

It should be noted that the original email which was identified as a "scam" made no reference to a Department of Georgia fundraiser, or a publication that would be sold to members of the Legion as part of fundraising initiative.

Also, prior to publishing Tuesday's e-newsletter this publication sought the opinions of several sources which included both post leadership and internet security professionals. All gave the email a 'thumbs down' and a scam or spam conclusion.

In addition, the Department's website, which was listed as a source for more information in the email in question, was reviewed and no mention of the email campaign was found on the site.

Thus the "scam" conclusion was reached and a warning to the membership was published. Subsequently we have also learned that a postcard mailing with the same "we need your information and please call within five days request" is also being received by Post 201 members.

At its worst, it still 'feels' like a scam. At best, it could fit into the category of 'bait and switch' advertising.

So as Paul Harvey would say, "And now you know...the rest of the story."

### Troop 51 to Hold Paint Recycling Fundraiser At Post Saturday, Sept. 23, 9 a.m. - 1 p.m.

Post-sponsored Troop 51 will hold a Paint Recycling Fundraiser from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m., Saturday, Sept. 23 in the Post's front parking lot. If you have left over paint and don't know what to do it, here's the answer.

The paint collected will be re-used by Atlanta Paint Disposal. It will be filtered and turned into a quality, reusable paint product that is then donated back to non-profit organizations in Georgia for beautification projects. Groups like Habitat for Humanity, Salvation Armies, and Boys & Girls Clubs are among those who will receive the recycled paint.

All latex and oil based paints in any size container (including spray cans) will accepted. The fundraising cost to donate paint is: Spray Can - \$2; Pint - \$2; Quart - \$2; Gallon - \$5; and 5-Gallon - \$25.
