Three Members of Auxiliary Recognized For Half-Century of Service to Organization

Three members of the Auxiliary - - Lee Harrison, Karen Hicks, and Burma Anderson - - were recognized at Tuesday night's General Membership meeting for 50 years of service as Auxiliary members.

Each received a 50-year Continuous Member Certificate which was jointly presented by Auxiliary President Linda Stancil-Redner and Post Commander Tom Billings. They were cited for "consistent loyalty to the American Legion Auxiliary" and for being an "outstanding contributor to the accomplishments" of the Auxiliary's programs.

Other highlights of Tuesday's meeting, which was attended by 27 Legionnaires as well as members of the Auxiliary who later adjourned to conduct their own meeting, and members of the SAL included:

- Celebrating the opening of the newly renovated kitchen which was followed by one of the best buffet meals served recently at General Membership meeting.
- A special "shout out" to Dave Kirchner, "Big" Mike Carroll and House Committee Chair Ralph Fike who spent countless hours on the kitchen renovation project.
- An update by Post Commander Tom Billings on the recent review of the Post and its activities which was conducted by District 9's Junior Vice Commander David Mullis.
- An announcement by Billings that he has requested an audit of the Post which will be conducted by the Department of Georgia. Billings said the review was expected to take two-three days and would consist of looking at the Post's overall operations, the CARES Act loan the Post received during Covid, how the Post has managed various programs including the Home Depot grant, various on-going entertainment programs at the Post, and how the Post administers activities that most Posts do not offer. He also said the audit would probably take place sometime during November. This is the first audit in more than a decade.

• Learning that SAL's recent 6th Annual Rick Gimpel Memorial Golf Tournament was considered to be the "most successful" of the six they have hosted over the years. The tournament had 36 foursomes (144 golfers) which was the maximum the course could accommodate. Scott Hoehn (also recently recognized for pulling together the Jimmy Buffett celebration) has produced a 5:40 video of the day's activities that may be viewed at this YouTube address.
