American Legion Post 328 in Flowery Branch and Post 7 in Gainesville, the Disabled American Veterans Chapter #17, and the PTSD Foundation of America will jointly host a one-day event to serve Veterans concerning the claims filing process.

The "Stand Down for Veterans In Need" to receive counseling claim services will be held Saturday, Nov. 4 from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. at St. Johns Baptist Church, 757 E. E. Butler Pkwy, Gainesville.

Veterans should bring their DD-214 if they have it. If they don't have one, applications to obtain a new one will be available.

The Georgia Department of Veterans Services (GDVS) and The Department of Veterans Affairs (DVA) will be giving a counseling claims clinic. If you have an existing claim with either the GDVS or the DVA bring your DD-214 to check the status of your claim.

Thanks to a Post 201 member, Lt. Col. Mike Mizell, U.S. Army (Ret), who is president of the Johns Creek Veterans Association (JCVA), and the SafeAmerica Foundation, along with other veterans service and civic organizations in the metro area, a new 'VetServe' program which is designed to provide services to the area's homeless veterans population, is approaching the launching pad.

Earlier this fall, Mizell, and Post 201 Commander Tom Billings held initial development discussion meetings with SafeAmerica CEO Len Pagano.

In addition to the JCVA and Post 201, other organizations involved in initial planning include the VFW, VetBuds, American Patriot Village, Warriors 2 Citizens, the Roswell Rotary Club and the Colonels Cup, which Mizell also helped found.

SafeAmerica is planning to host a 'Leap Forward' conference in Alpharetta on Thursday, Dec. 14. "We're proud of how Mizell started this conversation – and now we're doing some impressive work," said SafeAmerica's Pagano. For more information click here.
