Holiday Season Activities Include Post 201 Family Pot Luck Christmas Dinner, 7 p.m. Thursday, Dec. 21

Activities around the Post associated with the Holiday Season are starting to come together for the remaining days of 2023.

Even though it may not look or feel like a holiday event, tomorrow's **Bourbon and Cigar Night**, featuring Blade and Bow, a Kentucky straight bourbon whiskey, along with the other two bourbons on the tasting menu, Buffalo Trace and Woodford Reserve Double Oak, should leave those attending feeling somewhat in a celebratory mode - - particularly when the bourbon tastings are combined with a quality cigar and the evening's hors d'oeuvres which are being prepared and donated by Vision Warriors. It's not too late join the fun. Tickets are \$50 per person and may be purchased in the Clubroom/Bar.

Less than 24 hours later, the first load of **Toys for Tots** collected by the Post will be picked up by a contingent of U.S. Marines sometime on Saturday, Dec. 16. The pickup will include 100 assembled bicycles, which are scheduled to be delivered to the Post tomorrow, along with more than 225 toys collected during the past few weeks. But Saturday's shipment doesn't mean the drive is over. The Post will continue to collect toys until Tuesday, Dec. 19 at which time members of the Post will transfer the remaining toys donated since Saturday to an area collection point.

While the major load of toys are being picked up on Saturday at the Post, the Patriots of Liberty Chapter of the Daughters of the American Revolution's (DAR) will be placing **Christmas wreaths on veterans graves at eight area cemeteries**. Ceremonies at each site are scheduled to start at 12 noon. The cemeteries where the wreaths will be placed are Rest Haven, Pineview, Old Big Creek, Big Creek Primitive Baptist, Pleasant Hill Baptist, Providence Baptist, Rogers Bell, and Maxwell.

The Post supported the DAR's mission, which is part of the Wreaths Across America program, by purchasing 20 wreaths for them to place. Members of the Post are invited to attend any of the local wreath laying ceremonies. If interested contact the DAR coordinator Jennifer Boren at <u>jfboren52@gmail.com</u>. On Sunday, Dec. 17, the **West Coast Swing** crowd will hold their annual **Holiday Party** in the Ballroom. Party hosts Mark and Elizabeth Williams, and Suzy Filip want those attending to "wear red, green, or holiday bling" as they swing to the music of DJ Rich Kopels. The activities will get started at 6 p.m. with dance lessons; open dance will take the floor starting at 7:30 p.m. Admission for the evening is \$12 per person cash or Venmo.

A **Post 201 Family Pot Luck Christmas Party** and karaoke evening is on the planning calendar for Thursday evening Dec. 21, starting at 7 p.m. Recently appointed entertainment/event chair Dave Gordon is leading the charge on this one.

"It will be a true pot luck. Just bring a dish to share," he said. The bartending team will be whipping up a "Special Christmas Eggnog Spirit" for the evening which will be priced at \$3 each. Post member Scott Hoehn (of Jimmy

Buffett night fame) will be taking charge of the karaoke side of the Clubroom from 7 p.m. to 10 p.m. So come, bring a dish, and enjoy.

For those who'd like Christmas with a **Latin flavor, Xmas in Havana** is on the dance card for Friday night, Dec. 22. DJ Chris Stone will be playing the ultimate in Latin Fusion/Ballroom sounds for the evening. Beginner and intermediate Salsa dance lessons will be offered starting at 7:30 p.m. followed by open dance from 8:30 p.m. to 11:30 p.m.

Associated with the music genre of the same name, which was first popularized in the United States in the 1960s in New York City, Salsa is a mixture of Cuban dances, such as mambo, pachanga, and rumba, as well as American dances such as swing and tap. Admission for the evening is \$12 per person, cash or credit.

Continuing with the Holiday activities at the Post, the **Clubroom/Bar will be open from 1 p.m. to 7 p.m. on Christmas Eve**, Dec. 24. and the name of the **winner the Auxiliary Christmas Stocking Raffle will be drawn at 6 p.m.** - - - and you don't have to be present to win. But wouldn't it be fun to be there just in case your name was drawn?

The "official value" of the stocking, which is filled with assorted lotto cards and miniature liquor bottles, is set at \$200. But who knows? One of the \$100 in scratch off tickets might prove to be considerably more valuable. But as the rule says, "You can't win if you don't play."

On **New Year's Day, the Clubroom/Bar will open at 1 p.m.** instead of the usual 3 p.m. Monday opening. So plan to drop by. The Clubroom's four big TV screens should be awash with sports - - mostly football.

But it's also **Post 201 Oratorical Contest Day** with presentations scheduled to start at 10 a.m. in the Ballroom. The American Legion's annual competition is focused on the U.S. Constitution. Contestant (high school students in grades 9 - 12) prepare and give a speech on some aspect of the Constitution with some emphasis on the duties and obligation of citizens.

The top three winners at Post 201 will receive scholarship funding of: First Place - \$1,000; Second Place - \$750; and Third Place - \$500. Additional scholarship money may be earned at each level of competition with the winner at the national level earning more than \$25,000.

At this publication's deadline there are eight contestants scheduled for the Post's competition. They will be representing three high schools: Alpharetta, Chattahoochee and Innovation Academy.

Perhaps by Jan. 6 four more contestants might join the competition. If that happens, then the Post could have 12 orators orating, or 12 speakers speaking!
