Toys for Tots - - More than 100 bicycles and nearly 500 toys collected at the Post for the Toys for Tots campaign were delivered to the program's distribution center this past weekend. Coordinator Tommy Youngblood said this year's collections of toys was among the best in his memory - - and was nearly double what he projected at the beginning of the campaign.

Last year the campaign supported 494,380 Atlanta children. This year's goal is 500,000. If collections at other locations were as strong as they were at the Post, then that goal is going to be surpassed.

Founded in 1947, Toys for Tots is run by the U.S. Marine Corps Reserve. It began as a Los Angeles charitable effort when the wife of reserve Major Bill Hendricks tried to donate a homemade Raggedy Ann doll to a needy child but could not find any organization to do so. At her suggestion, he gathered a group of local Marine reservists who coordinated and collected some 5,000 toys for local children that year from collection bins placed outside Warner Bros. movie theatres.

Last year the campaign delivered more than 24 million toys to children in all 50 states as well as the District of Columbia, Puerto Rico, Guam and the Virgin Islands.

13,000 Boxes for the Troops - - Steve Olesnevich (or SteveO as he is known around the Post), reports that he has crossed over the 13,000 mark in boxes shipped to the troops. The program got started some 20 years ago when he saw a newspaper story about boxes for the troops. Thinking it was a rather good idea he took it to then Post leadership Dennis Turner and his wife Barbara. As he tells the story, Barbara listened to his idea and then said, "handle it." So he did.

Two decades later, he's still going strong, although he has picked up some support from "Big" Mike Carroll who is often seen helping SteveO pack and ship. Each box, with goodies weighing between 10-11 pounds, now costs \$22 to ship. When he started doing it, boxes shipped to the to the troops at either an APO or FPO address could be shipped for about \$12.50.

On average SteveO says it takes about an hour to prepare each box - - - 20 minutes to gather the goodies, 20 minutes to pack it, and 20 minutes per box getting it in the mail at the Alpharetta post office!

If you have a moment, say thanks to SteveO for his work on behalf of the Post. And ask him to show you some of his "thank you" notes from the troops. They are truly a testimony to his efforts.
