'Sinatra and Friends' Show Back on the Books for Mar. 15

The "Sinatra and Friends" tribute show, also known locally as the Atlanta Rat Pack, which was originally scheduled at the Post last Fall, is back on the books again - - - now scheduled for 8 p.m. Friday, March 15 at the Post.

General admission non-refundable tickets are \$20 each. They may be purchased online by <u>clicking</u> <u>here</u>, or at the Clubroom/Bar starting this weekend.

Doors for the show will open at 6:30 p.m. Free dance lessons will be provided for half-an-hour starting 7:30 p.m. In addition to 'Sinatra and Friends,' DJ Rich Kopels will be providing dance music during show intermissions.

If Sinatra and Friends isn't enough, a second 'legends show' is being added to the Post's entertainment schedule. At Tuesday evening's general membership meeting, the 22 Legion members attending unanimously approved adding a 'family-friendly" tribute show which is scheduled for Friday, May 31.

While all the details for the May show are still being ironed out, the anticipated ticket price will be \$30 per person. Tribute performers for this show will include the Blues Brothers, Mick Jagger, Buddy Holly, The Big Bopper and Joe Cocker.

However, no variety show is complete without a host - - - so this show will be hosted by the one-and-only New York entertainment columnist, Ed Sullivan, whose weekly variety show ran on CBS television from June 20, 1948, to March 28, 1971.

Post Membership Renewal Drive - - The Post, according to national's count at Jan. 13, stands at 613 members currently holding 2024 membership cards. This represents 87.5 per cent toward the
