Post Flags to Half Staff Feb. 17; Honors One of Three Soldiers Killed in Jordan

Governor Brian Kemp has ordered the U.S. and Georgia state flags to half-staff on all state buildings and grounds on Saturday, Feb. 17, the day Sgt Kennedy Landon Sanders, 24, of Waycross will be interred.

She, along with two other Georgians, Sgt. William Jerome Rivers, 46, of Carrollton, and Sgt Breonna Alexsondria Moffett , 23, of Savannah, were killed in a drone strike last week in Jordan. All were assigned to the 718th Engineer Company, 926th Engineer Battalion, 926th Engineer Brigade, Fort Moore (formerly Fort Benning) Ga.

Kemp says he'll issue the same executive order for the other fallen Army sergeants when their funeral arrangements are finalized.

The Post has placed three crosses at the intersection of Wills Road and Old Milton/Rucker Road to honor the three. Flags at the Post will also be lowered in accordance with the Governor's request for the all three on the appropriate days.
