Jim Ruska To Receive Spirit of North Ga. Award

Post 201 dual member Jim Ruska will be awarded the Ralph Colley Spirit of North Georgia Award by University of North Georgia (UNG) at a dinner awards ceremony scheduled for Friday, Apr. 19.

Jim, a retired Marine Captain, was awarded two Purple Hearts during his service in Vietnam. He is a 1969 graduate of North Georgia College (now UNG), and a graduate of North Fulton High School in Atlanta.

The Ralph Colley Award is given to an alumni who has experienced adverse circumstances in his or her life and has risen above those circumstances to live an exemplary life. The award is not necessarily awarded annually. The decision to award is at the discretion of the UNGAA Awards Committee.

Ralph Colley, North Georgia College Class of 1966, lost three limbs to a land mine in Vietnam. He was the award's first recipient.

Window to Apply for College Scholarships Now Open; Application Deadline April 1 The window is now open for graduating high school seniors interested in applying for one of the Post's \$1,500 scholarships. The deadline to apply is April 1. The awards are based on academic achievement, a 300-500-word essay: *Patriotism and Citizenship – What America Means to Me*, participation in school and community activities and must be sponsored by a member of Post 201.

This year the Post anticipates presenting up to five scholarships. The SAL anticipates awarding one scholarship, also valued at \$1,500. The SAL award is based on the same criteria as the Legion program. The Auxiliary also has a scholarship, but no information was available on that award at publication deadline. Georgia Boys State Program Seeking Participants; Deadline to Apply, May 10

Qualified male rising high school seniors interested in attending Boys State this June need to submit their applications to the Post not later than May 10. Although the state application itself says the cost to attend is \$300, applicants selected attend by the Post will have that fee paid by the Post. Applicants applying to the Post should submit their applications to the Post not later than May 10.

Georgia Boys State is a comprehensive one week course in state and local government and is a program of the American Legion Department of Georgia. The date for the program is June 9-15, 2024 and will be held at Valdosta State University in Valdosta. The program is a "leadership action program" where participating male high school rising seniors take part in a practical government course.
