Post Takes Steps to Launch \$1.5 Million Capital Campaign

Tuesday evening the Executive Committee took the first step of a process to put the Post on a firm financial footing when it approved a plan to launch a \$1.5 million capital campaign that will take place between now and the end of the summer.

The planning process assumes that solicitation material development and other pre-campaign launch activities will take place during the March-early May time frame, with the formal launch taking place in late May – early June window. The formal portion of the campaign will be complete by August, although it is reasonable to expect some residual funds will flow into the Post for the next 60-days or so.

Insight Political Group, LLC of Cumming, a well-known and respected fund raising organization that works in the non-profit capital campaign marketplace as well as on both sides of the aisle in the political environment' is guiding the Post's campaign.

The campaign is looking at four primary funding areas:

- Repairs and maintenance which include the need to replace to building roof, resurface the parking lot, improving the entry-way to the Post, and establishing a reserve fund for future, unplanned major expenses - something the Post has not done for more than a decade.
- Venue Upgrades which include new furniture in the ballroom, restoring the dance floor, bringing the kitchen to a commercial grade standard, rebuilding the sound stage, and making significant improvements to the entrance foyer and the men and women's restrooms that serve the ballroom.
- Educational upgrades which include Walk of Memory maintenance, funds for maintaining the two aircraft, the tank and the gun platform (all of which are on loan with the understanding that they will be kept in good repair), signage enhancements that could include an interactive discussion associated with each plaza on the Walk, and other educational outreach undertakings to more aggressively promote the Walk as a destination location for local area tourism.
- Sports facility improvements which include replacing the 500 seats along the first and third base lines, a new scoreboard, updated broadcasting equipment for the press box, and additional concession stand improvements.

"This campaign provides us the opportunity to put the Post on a firm, healthy, long-term financial footing. That's something we did not have in place when Covid-19 forced us to close the Post for a period of time. At that time no steps had been taken to build a reserve fund that would protect the Post financially, or much less to build the resources to undertake major updates to our aging facilities," said Post Commander Tom Billings.

"We don't need to have that happen to us again at some future date. This campaign will take us a long way toward ensuring our future," he added.
