Come Celebrate St. Pat's Day at the Post

St. Patrick's Day at the Post this Sunday is going to be a busy one. In addition to the regular 3rd Sunday of the month pool tournament which starts a 2 p.m., the following activities are laid on for the one day of the year when "everybody is Irish."

When the Clubroom/Bar opens at 1 p.m. Jameson Irish Whiskey, Guinness Beer, and Baileys Irish Cream will be on sale for \$3 each; and a special Irish Car Bomb cocktail will be on the drink menu for \$7.

For those not familiar with the Irish Car Bomb, which is also known in other places around the world as an Irish slammer, Irish bomb shot, or a Dublin drop, is a cocktail similar to a boilermaker. It's made by dropping a bomb shot of Irish cream and Irish whiskey into a glass of Irish stout. The

whiskey is floated on top of the Irish cream in a shot glass, and the shot glass is then dropped into the stout.

The "specials" will be available all day, or until the required liquors are exhausted.

Weather permitting, the Auxiliary's Community Easter Egg Hunt on the front lawn of the Post will get started at 2 p.m. It's free to the public and children ages 1-12 are welcome to participate. If it's raining you can be assured that the planners have a 'rainy day hunt' plan as a backup.

The SAL Liquor Basket Raffle Drawing is scheduled for 5 p.m. Don't know when ticket sales will be stopped prior to the drawing, but knowing Derek, he'll drag every dollar he can out of those who are awaiting the drawing even though you do not have to be present to win. Tickets available at Clubroom/Bar: 1 ticket for \$5; 3 tickets for \$10; 10 tickets for \$20.

Free 'VetTran' Service Launched; Helps Non-Driving Vets Keep Appointments

The SafeAmerica Foundation, a Marietta-based not-for-profit that provides services to the community, has launched a free transportation service to assist veterans who cannot drive.

The organization's VetTran program will provide veterans free rides to medical appointments as well as other social service appointments such as going to a housing provider, a job program or a social security office.

Focused on providing service mainly in the greater metro-Atlanta area, service is available primarily Monday through Friday. Availability of the service also depends on the location of the requesting vet and where he/she needs to travel along with the day and time.

Requests for transportation support should be made at least 48 hours in advance by calling SafeAmerica's main number, 770-973-7233, or sending an email to the program coordinator, Steve Mason, at steve.mason@safeamerica.org.

Once the request is made, a member of the SafeAmerica team will contact the requestor for more information and let the requester know if transportation can be provided at the at the requested time.
