Post Open on Easter Sunday Despite Rumors to the Contrary

Contrary to "bar talk" and the Post's rumor mill, the Post's Clubroom/Bar will be open this Easter Sunday starting at the regular 1 p.m. weekend opening time.

It appears that the rumor about closing this Sunday may have gotten started because the Post, according to the Executive Committee meeting minutes of July 12, 2022, recognizes four holidays: Easter Sunday, Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Eve and Christmas Day.

However, the identification of these four 'holidays' are for the purpose of paying staff at a time-and-a-half rate if they work on one of those four days. Traditionally, the Post has not closed on Easter Sunday, but has closed on Christmas Day. Christmas Eve has often been a day which the Post closes earlier than on a regular day, and the same has been true on Thanksgiving Day - - - sometimes.

For example, on Thanksgiving Day 2023 the Post was open from 11 a.m. to 5 p.m. and offered a "Pot Luck Turkey Day" for members of the Post family who may not have been celebrating with their family and friends. But the bar was not open that afternoon for alcohol service.

In short, Post 'holidays' do not translate into the Post being closed. Those open/close decisions are made, or reconfirmed by the Executive Committee each year as that specific holiday approaches.

National Vietnam War Veterans Day Scheduled for Tomorrow

Tomorrow is National Vietnam War Veterans Day - - a time to pay special tribute to the nine million Americans who served during the Vietnam War era, to the 58,000 names memorialized on the Vietnam Veterans Memorial in Washington, D.C., and to those who never received the recognition they deserved when they returned to the U.S. from war.

Any Post 201 member who performed active military, naval, or air service in the Republic of Vietnam and its surrounding waters during the Vietnam War will be given one drink chip at the Clubroom/Bar on the Mar. 29 upon request.

The chip may be used that afternoon or any other time the Vietnam Vet member might choose. At publication deadline, no other special activities than the drink chip award were planned in the Clubroom/Bar.

Locally, ceremonies to honor the day are scheduled in Roswell starting at 8:30 a.m. at the Faces of War Memorial located behind City Hall. In Johns Creek ceremonies are scheduled at the Veterans Walk in Newtown Park starting at 12 noon. The Johns Creek ceremony is sponsored by the Johns Creek Veterans Association and the Atlanta Vietnam Veterans Business Association.

Background About the Day

The Vietnam War Veterans Recognition Act, signed into law in 2017, designates March 29 of each year as National Vietnam War Veterans Day.

Though there is some debate, March 29 is generally viewed as the most appropriate date since that's day in 1973 the U.S. Military Assistance Command, Vietnam was disestablished. It was also the day the last U.S. combat troops departed Vietnam. In addition, on and around this same day, the U.S. Vietnam War Commemoration stated that Hanoi released the last of its acknowledged prisoners of war.

4 Important Things to Know About Vietnam Veterans

The inclusive dates of the Vietnam War itself were Nov. 1, 1955 to May 15, 1975. The 1955 date coincides with the official designation of Military Assistance Advisory Group-Vietnam (MAAG-V). The 1975 date marks the end of the battle period which was precipitated by the seizure of the SS Mayaguez.
