Ed Sullivan Tribute Show Cancelled

Late Monday afternoon, after looking at extremely slow ticket sales four days before the scheduled performance, Post leadership decided to cancel tomorrow's Ed Sullivan tribute show.

Writing in a jointly-signed email to all who had purchased tickets, current Post Commander Tom Billings and Post Commander-elect Bob Byrd said, "Cancelling the show was a difficult decision to make, but ticket sales were not reaching our expectations."

However they also said that cancelling this Friday's show was not a harbinger for the future shows. "We are not stepping away from seeking opportunities to bring our community entertainment which recalls fond memories of earlier years," they said in the email.

Tribute performers for the cancelled show included the Blues Brothers, Mick Jagger, Buddy Holly, The Big Bopper and Joe Cocker. All ticket holders received a full refund including fees associated with purchasing tickets online. Only 46 tickets had been sold when the cancel decision was made.

Noting that the Ed Sullivan Show was following the "recent, and highly successful, Frank Sinatra tribute show" they said expectations were high for The Ed Sullivan tribute show. Trying to pinpoint why ticket sales were slow the email said, "We believe there were several reasons for (slow ticket sales) - - - among them the choice of the last Friday in May as the show date."
