Budweiser Clydesdales Set Visit at Post, July 6

A team of Budweiser Clydesdales is scheduled to visit the Post on Saturday afternoon, July 6. Their visit is part of joint fundraising and promotion campaign with Folds of Honor.

While some details associated with their visit still need to be nailed down, the horses will take a two-mile walking tour of Alpharetta starting late morning, July 6. The tour will start at Innovation Academy in the 11 a.m. time frame, swing by City Hall and the Saturday morning Farmer's Market, make a brief stop at Wills Park (the parking lot along Milton Avenue next to the tennis courts) and then stroll over to the Post where their "visit to the city" will draw to a close.

They'll rest at the Post for a couple of hours before being loaded onto their trailers and leave for the next stop on their promotional itinerary. While at the Post members of the community are welcome to come see them.

Since their visit will be part of the Thursday though Saturday, July 4-6 period, the Post will be making arrangements to entertain guests from the community who would like an 'up close and personal' opportunity to see the horses with food for sale, a Budweiser beer-on-tap trailer which will be at the Post for several days including July 4th, a bounce house for children and other activities including a two-day baseball tournament on July 5 and 6.
