Old Soldiers Day

Saturday, Aug. 3 will be the highlight of the next two weeks as the Post celebrates its 72nd Annual Old Soldiers Day by honoring this year, 'All Women Who Have Served.'

The days activities, which will be open to the public, will begin with a 20-25 minute ceremony on the Walk of Memory grounds at 10 a.m. It will be followed by a reception in the ballroom for all the women vets who attend the event.

The guest speaker will be Martina Schmidt, USAF-Ret., Chairwoman of the "She Served Initiative." The Alpharetta City Band Brass Ensemble will provide music before and after the program. Scouts from Troop 51 will present the colors, and a memorial brick "Honoring All Women Who Served" will be added to the Walk of Memories.

For the remainder of the day all women veterans and those who are on active duty or the active reserve will be able to purchase any wine or liquor the bar serves for \$1 less than the published price for that particular beverage.

The day will concluded with a two-hour "Big Band" show and dance in the ballroom starting at 8 p.m. The 22-member Alpha Jazz, formed in 2018 under the Alpharetta City Band umbrella, brings a distinctly different genre of music to the Alpharetta scene.

Made up of trumpets, trombones, saxophones, a rhythm section and vocalists, this talented group of musicians play a repertoire or music from the 1940s to the 1970s.

Last week's e-newsletter had a partial list of Big Band 'sounds' the audience can expect to hear. However, responding to several requests made of this publication during the past week, here are a few more pieces that are on the Band's playlist: *Ain't That A Kick in the Head, Jumpin' At the Woodside, Luck Be A Lady, Mambo Italiano, One O'Clock Jump, Pennsylvania 6-5000, Sing-Sing, Stardust, At the Woodchoppers Ball, and Chega De Saudade (No More Blues).*
