Georgia WW II Vet Burial Set for Saturday, Remains Identified 80 Years After His Death

The remains of a World War II veteran, who was unidentified for nearly 80 years, will be laid to rest Saturday in Fitzgerald, Ga.

The Georgia Military Veterans' Hall of Fame (GMVHOF), on behalf of the family of U.S. Army PFC Luther Elwood "Buck" Bagley, has extended an invitation to all veterans to attend his 10:30 a.m. Military Graveside Ceremony at Evergreen Cemetery in Fitzgerald. It will be conducted by the U.S Army 75th Ranger Regiment for World War II, according to the GMVHOF.

In mid-1944, Buck was a replacement for the 5307th Composite Unit Provisional, famously known as "Merrill's Marauders." On July 25, 1944, at the age of 22, he was initially listed as "Missing-in- Action." That was later changed to "Killed-In-Action" as a result of a battle in Myitkyina, Burma (today's Myanmar). This battle was the last combat action for Merrill's Marauders during the war. On August 10, 1944 the Marauders were disbanded.

Sometime later, Buck's widow, Eleanor (who was 19 at the time), was informed of her husband's MIA / KIA status. During the war, Eleanor was a "Rosie the Riveter" working at the Savannah shipyards and she was also the mother of their 11-month-old baby boy, Nathan or "Woody".

Due to the chaos of war, Buck's remains, as were the remains of others, were recovered from the battle field area several years after the war. But at that time they could not be positively identified. However, in April 2024, after almost 80 years, his remains were finally identified via DNA testing at the Defense POW/MIA Accounting Agency (DPAA) in Hawaii.

Eleanor, who will turn 100-years-old on September 6, and son Woody, now 80, were informed on May 14, 2024 that the remains of their husband and father had been identified and would finally be coming home. Their eight decades wait was finally over.

Upon hearing the news, Eleanor's response was, "I have been waiting with a broken heart for 80 years and now the love of my life is coming home."

Buck Bagley was inducted into the Georgia Military Veterans' Hall of Fame, Inductee #163, on November 4, 2023.
