3rd Annual Kabul 13 Remembrance Ceremony Set for Saturday, Aug. 24

The Johns Creek Veterans Association will hold their 3rd annual ceremony honoring the Kabul 13 on Saturday, Aug. 24, at 10 a.m. at the Veterans Memorial Walk's Afghan Plaza at Newtown Park in Johns Creek. The Knights of Columbus will be working with the JCVA Color Guard to conduct the ceremony.

Eleven Marines, one Navy corpsman and one Army soldier were killed during a suicide bombing on Aug. 26, 2021, near the Abbey Gate of the Hamid Karzai International Airport in Kabul, Afghanistan. The blast also killed hundreds of Afghan civilians.

Eighteen U.S. military service members and many more Afghans were wounded in the attack at the crowded entry gate where they were working to rescue Americans and Afghans fleeing the Taliban.
