## Drink Price Increase at Post To Take Effect Friday, Nov. 1

Effective Friday, Nov. 1, the cost of beer, wine and liquor will be increased. Drink prices for members of the Post Family will climb by 50 cents per drink. Non-member prices will be increased by \$1 per drink.

The increase is designed to cover the continuing rise in the cost of buying beer, wine and liquor from distributors as well a covering the increased state taxes the Post must pay which accompanies the increased price of alcohol. Finance officer Ralph Jordan told the membership at Tuesday night's General Membership Meeting that the Post's alcohol tax bill is in the range of \$15,000 per year.

In looking at the cost increase, the Executive Committee considered just adding sales tax to every purchase made at the bar, but rejected the idea since it would place a significant additional burden on the bar staff who would have to deal with pennies, nickels, dimes and quarters for those who pay cash, as well as assuring that tax is added to every credit card bill.

A number of other Post were surveyed during the review which lead to the general consensus that increasing the price on each drink by an amount sufficient to include sales tax within the drink price and to also cover the increased costs associated with buying alcoholic products would be the best option.

During Tuesday night's meeting, which was attended by only 20 members of the Post, Commander Bob Byrd announced that a memorandum of understanding (MOU) has been signed with the Alpharetta Rotary Club.

Under the terms of the MOU, the Rotary Club will pay for approximately \$77,000 in repairs and upgrades to the ballroom, entrance foyer, vestibule and the two bathrooms adjacent to the ballroom. Construction is expected to start by the end of the month and take two or three weeks to complete.

Repair work will start early in the morning, with the work crews making every effort to avoid disturbing Clubroom/Bar operations during the afternoon and evening, and evening activities and meeting in the ballroom.

During the meeting, Byrd advised members that:

**Bingo is Back** with the first two 'bingo afternoons' at the Post scheduled for 2 p.m. Sunday, Oct. 13 and Sunday, Nov. 10. The Auxiliary is taking the lead in conducting the games and the SAL is working with them.

The **SAL is planning a cookout** at the Post on Saturday, Sept. 28, the evening of the Georgia-Alabama football game. Kickoff time is 7:30 p.m. Currently the SAL plans to start food service in the 7 p.m. time frame.

**Ten new members** - - two transfers and eight new members including one currently on active duty - - were added to the Post's American Legion membership roles.

## Used Medical Equipment Collection Container at Post

The Friends of Disabled Adults and Children (FODAC) has signed a partnership agreement with the Post which permits a 40-foot container, that serves as a collection and distribution point for new and gently used home medical equipment for those in need, to be placed Post's back parking lot.

The container was delivered yesterday. The Rotary Clubs of Roswell and Alpharetta will manage the project along with support from the Rotary Clubs of Johns Creek and North Fulton. Other partners, along with Post 201 include Vision Warriors and the VFW (Veterans of Foreign Wars).

Donations can be dropped off at the container. Items which are in high demand items will be sanitized and redistributed locally by distribution partners to clinics, hospitals, and other healthcare workers.

Equipment requiring further repair or not immediately needed will be stored for FODAC to collect. FODAC repairs, refurbishes, and reissues donated equipment such as wheelchairs, scooters, patient lifts, and hospital beds for a minimal one-time registration fee of \$25. The organization annually provides around 8,000 items to 3,000-4,000 clients.

The new collection site at the Post is part of FODAC's strategy to increase its annual collection and refurbishment from 10,000 to 14,000 items to meet growing demand. For more information about FODAC and its services, visit <a href="www.fodac.org">www.fodac.org</a>.
