The remainder of the funds raised will be distributed to core mission activities outlined in the current year's SAL budget.

The SAL cited the support of platinum level sponsors Top Golf and Clark Brothers, all those who participated in the tournament, Auxiliary Unit 201, and Posts 201, 251, 42, 47, SAL Squadrons 42 and 47, Bedoe's Bar and Grill and the SAL 201 volunteers for their contribution to making this year's tournament "the most successful ever".
