### Saturday's Cruz-In Called 'Best Ever'

This past Saturday's 8th Annual Cruz-In at the Post of classic, exotic, vintage, custom, military, off-road, muscle and military vehicles "was the best car show we've ever had." That how Cruz-In committee chair Tommy Youngblood described this past Saturday's show at Tuesday night's Executive Committee meeting. The parking lot was "filled to capacity for the first time in the show's history," he said.

One committee member, who was trying to count the number of cars on exhibit, stopped counting when he reached 130 automobiles. And he also noted that several cars were turned away during the day because there was no space for them.

At the height of the day estimates suggest that there were in excess of 500 people on the Post grounds - - - either looking at the cars and talking with the owners; enjoying the pleasant weather while visiting the Walk of Memories; or watching children bounce around on one of the two bounce houses at the Post's front door.

Others were paying attention to a small group of youngsters playing ball on the grounds in front of the tank, while some 100 or so were watching the 1st Annual Stars and Stripes - American Legion Baseball Game on Veterans Field. The Georgia Jackets were the 'Stripes' for the day and Aviator Nation were the 'Stars'. For the record, the Stripes beat the Stars 6 to 3.

While the final financials on the show are still being calculated, Tommy estimates that income after expenses will be in the range of \$4,500 - - - and he also reported there was "no food left over at the end of the day - - it was all sold out."

During the weeks leading up to the show Tommy periodically reminded others that this would be the last year he would be the Cruz-In committee chair. But when the observation was made at Tuesday night's meeting that he was leaving an enormous legacy for next year's chair to fill, Tommy's face sparkled with that amusing smile which crosses his face rather often and said, "I'll probably be around next year."
