Post to Celebrate 'Wild Turkey Day' Wednesday, Nov. 27

Wild Turkey Day, a holiday that is celebrated annually on the day after the Thanksgiving holiday is going to be pushed forward by two days at the Post this year. And "yes," Wild Turkey Bourbon will be part of the afternoon and evening celebration which gets started when the Clubroom/Bar opens at 3 p.m. on Wednesday, Nov. 27, the day before Thanksgiving Day.

Turkey and ham (compliments of the Post) will be served starting around 4 p.m. Members of the Post Family who participate are asked to bring a pot-luck dish to share. Wild Turkey Bourbon shots (\$5 per shot) will be the featured drink of the day, along with Karaoke (although a set time for the music was not available by publishing deadline).

Wild Turkey Day, or WTD actually occurs each year on the same day as Black Friday. The idea being that WTD offers a healthy alternative to Black Friday by giving people more time to spend with friends, and avoid both shopping and complaining about shopping.

But the Post is providing its Family members the opportunity to do both by celebrating WTD two days earlier than the 'official' holiday - - - which leaves time for shopping on Black Friday!

Other significant items covered during the meeting:

- The membership, by a unanimous vote, cancelled the December General Membership Meeting. This action carries forward the tradition of not holding December meetings. The Auxiliary, in its meeting last Tuesday night, also said they will not hold a December meeting.
- Again this year the Post will be a Toys for Tots drop off location. Boxes are already available in the Clubroom and the Ballroom for donations, with a collection deadline currently set for either December 21 or 22. As in past years a selection of toys will be available at the bar starting the day before Thanksgiving. Members may purchase them and then put them in the donation boxes. Also, members are reminded that since the Post is a drop off location, members of the surrounding community may be bringing their donations to Post to put in our drop boxes. Be sure to welcome them and thank them for their participation.
- The Post will be closed on Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day but open on the day before Thanksgiving and also Christmas Eve.
- Pearl Harbor Day this year (Saturday Dec. 7) is also a college football championship game day. The SAL plans to provide 'heavy' appetizers (wings, sandwiches and other finger foods) in the Clubroom/Bar that afternoon starting around 4 p.m. SAL Commander Derek Garmon says a 50/50 raffle is also on the afternoon's entertainment list. And he suggested that some members of the Post family may want to bring a pot-luck dish to compliment the hors d'oeuvres being provided by the SAL. Post Commander Bob Byrd said a special drink would be identified for the day.

- The U.S. Space Force celebrates its birthday on Wednesday, Dec. 20. A special drink will be identified for that day in keeping with the developing tradition at the Post to have a special drink (sold at a slightly reduced price) so all veterans, whether a member of the Post or not, as well as any active duty members who might be in the Clubroom/Bar that day can toast their sister service with one or more celebratory drinks.
