Stephen Olesnevich

Dec. 5, 1940 - Jan. 2, 2025

Steve'O, as he was known at the Post, was a U.S. Army Vietnam veteran and a 35-year member of the American Legion. For more than 20 years he was the mainstay of the Post's "Boxes for the Troops" program. Last year he calculated he had mailed more than 13,000 boxes containing candy, snacks, books and personal care items to troops deployed throughout the world.

According to an article published by Appen Media on Nov. 22, 2022, funds donated by area residents and local businesses to support the box program at that time exceeded \$100,000. Since then additional donations have pushed the total to well over \$150,000.

A memorial service at the Post will be scheduled at an as yet-to-be-determined date.

Richard Alan Dudley April 4, 1949 – Jan. 7, 2025

Alan, a Class of 1971 West Point graduate, was a 15-year member of the American Legion. From 2020-2023 he was a member of the Post's executive committee. He served as Post Commander from 2020-2022, a period of time which included leading the Post through the Covid-19 crisis.

He may be best remembered for his personal commitment during the Covid period for disinfecting the Post 2-3 times per week. He would start spraying in the Ballroom, working his way through the Clubroom and ending that day's disinfectant spraying in the kitchen. He also made arrangements for members of the Post to schedule appointments for Covid vaccinations at a Dunwoody-area medical facility so they wouldn't have to contend with waiting in line at other walk-in locations.

In addition to his Post Commander leadership, he also served as the baseball committee chair during his time as a member of the executive committee and for a period of time after that. As baseball committee chair he was instrumental in guiding the nearly \$40,000 renovation of the baseball field concession stand from start to finish.

American Legion National Commander To Visit Post, 3 p.m. Thursday, Jan. 16

James A. LaCoursiere, Jr., the American Legion national commander, is slated to visit the Post from 3 p.m. to 4 p.m. on Thursday, Jan. 16. Members of the Post interested in visiting with him that afternoon are invited to attend an informal reception hosted by Post Commander Bob Byrd.

The national commander's visit to the Post is part of a four-day, Jan. 15-18 visit to the state. District 9 is hosting him on the 16th. Other stops in District 9, along with his visit to the Post, include the Johns Creek Veterans Memorial Walk at Newtown Park, the VA Hospital in Decatur, a BBQ lunch at Post 45 in Canton, and a dinner at Post 127 in Sugar Hill.

LaCoursiere, who is a U.S. Air Force veteran, was elected national commander on Aug. 29, 2024, at the 105th National Convention in New Orleans. He has been a longtime field representative for the American Legion Department of Connecticut's Soldiers, Sailors and Marines Fund, which financially assists veterans and their families in need. He has also held many leadership positions at American Legion post, department and national levels.

He is a member of American Legion Post 91 in Moosup, Conn. He has also served as a national vice commander, Connecticut state commander, and chairman of the national Legislative Commission.
