### National Commander Says Vet Suicide is #1 Issue for Vets

During an approximately one hour meet-and-greet visit at the Post last Thursday afternoon, American Legion National Commander James A. LaCoursiere, Jr. spent most of his time chatting informally with some 20-plus Legionnaires as well as a several members of the Auxiliary and the SAL.

However, before departing he offered brief prepared remarks about the national organization's "Be the One" campaign to help reduce veteran suicide and actions that individual Legion members, as well as Posts, can take to participate in the campaign.

"The number one issue facing the veteran community today is suicide," he said. It is estimated that between 17 and 22 veterans or service members take their lives each day. He also observed that the rate of suicide for veterans is more than 50 per cent higher than that of non-veteran adults.

He stressed that individual veterans could support the national initiative by asking other veterans how they are doing if they believe he or she is struggling with an issue, taking time to listen when a fellow vet needs to talk, and encourage a struggling vet to reach out for support which is available 24/7/365. Following his brief remarks he seemed somewhat surprised, but appreciative when the Post's SAL Commander stepped up to the podium and presented him a \$100 donation from the SAL to support the "Be the One" campaign
