VA Announces Major Survivor Benefit Reforms

The Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) announced earlier this week a three-pronged approach to eliminate barriers and streamline the process for how eligible survivors and dependents of deceased Veterans and service members apply for and receive VA benefits and services.

Specific improvements include:

The VA's Office of Survivors Assistance will be moved from the Veterans Benefits Administration to the Office of the VA Secretary, reversing a Biden-era decision that buried OSA under layers of bureaucracy.

A "white-glove" survivor outreach team will be created by the VA starting this month to guide and assist eligible survivors throughout their Dependency and Indemnity Compensation (DIC) claims process.

Starting immediately, VA will begin work to identify areas where automation can be used to make the DIC claims process easier to navigate for survivors.

"The last thing survivors need in their time of grief is frustrating red tape and bureaucracy. That's why we are creating a better system to more quickly and effectively provide survivors the services, support and compassion they've earned," said VA Secretary Doug Collins.

A memorial service for Anthony "Tony" Lay is schedule for 11 a.m. Monday, May 12 at Mt. Bethel Church, [4385 Lower Roswell Road, Marietta 30068](#). A reception at the Post 201 Ballroom will follow that same afternoon. It is scheduled for 3:30 p.m. to 6. p.m.

At the time of his death he was a member both Post 201 and a long-time member of VFW Post 12002, both in Alpharetta. During the Vietnam War he was captured and held briefly before being freed by friendly forces.

Rolling Thunder Founder, POW/MIA Accountability Advocate Dead at 80

The POW/MIA community lost one of its best known leaders with the recent death of Artie Muller, the founder and executive director of Rolling Thunder, Inc. Muller died on Saturday, April 26, a few days after his 80th birthday.

Like many veterans returning home after the Vietnam War he was haunted by reports of men left behind— both accounted and unaccounted for. But uniquely, he channeled those feelings into advocating for Prisoners of War & Missing in Action, and turned that concern into a national movement. In 1994, he formed Rolling Thunder Inc, a veteran's organization that has expanded over the years to 90 chapters throughout the U.S. and overseas.

For more than 25 years he and his organization hosted the annual Rolling Thunder First Amendment Demonstration Run or "Ride for Freedom" during the Memorial Day weekend in Washington, D.C.

Entertainer Nancy Sinatra wrote on her FaceBook page that he was, "one of the most important men in my life. I rode behind him on his bike and I felt like a princess. Year after year we traveled together for Rolling Thunder. He was the heart and soul of that tremendous effort and I will never forget him and his dedication to all veterans. He taught me so much about giving."

According to the Military Times, "The event was one of the largest annual veterans events in America, routinely drawing tens of thousands of riders to the National Mall each Memorial Day

weekend. But organizers ended the tradition in 2019, citing the growing costs of crowd control and a lack of consistent cooperation from leaders at the Pentagon, whose parking lot was used as a pre-parade staging area.”
