### Post to Host Memorial Day Open House for Community

Post 201 will celebrate Memorial Day this Monday by holding an Open House for the general public from 1 p.m. to 7 p.m. In addition to the Post's Walk of Memories, which is always open to the public, members of the local community are invited to participate in other activities that afternoon.

Two showings of the Atlanta Vietnam Veterans Business Association Foundation's 47-minute documentary video "Truths and Myths about The Vietnam War" which includes an introduction by actor Sam Elliott is the main item on the activity list. The showings, on the large screen in the Post's ballroom, are scheduled for 1:30 p.m. and 3 p.m.

Post 201 member Jim Dickson, who is chairman of the film committee which produced the documentary will introduce it at each showing and then answer audience questions about its production following each showing.

The video honors those who served in the Vietnam War by addressing the decades of misinformation that has presented a skewed historical perspective of the war which officially ended 50 years ago.

In addition to the video, members of the Post and guests from the local community can take advantage of:

-Complimentary chicken wings, chicken strips, hamburgers and hot dogs prepared by the Sons of the American Legion. Food service will start at 2 p.m. and will continue until all the food is consumed.

-A bounce house to entertain the children, along with other outdoor "yard" games which will be set up set up on the Post's front lawn.

-Access to the Post's Clubroom/Bar. All drinks purchased during Memorial Day will be served at member prices to both members and guests.

The day's last scheduled activity will be a brief memorial ceremony at 5 p.m. at the Post's Circle of Flags. This gathering will honor the courage, sacrifice, and enduring legacy of the men and women who gave their lives in service to the United States and to also remember the Nation's Prisoners of War and those still Missing in Action.

### 10 Young People Represent Post 201 at Boys, Girls State

Six boys and four girls representing Post 201 are scheduled to attend the Georgia Department's Boys State and Girls State programs in Valdosta next month.

Girls State delegates and their respective high schools are: Allison Yang, home schooled; Saanvi Kadiyala, Milton HS; Shree Patadia, Innovation Academy; and Santana Uppaluri, Fulton Science Academy.

Boys State delegates are: John Cario and Michael Herger, both from Blessed Trinity Catholic HS; Daniel Dri, West Forsyth HS; Raunak Gupta, Johns Creek HS; Lijun Xu, Mt. Pisgah Christian School; and Edwin Tang, Northview HS.

Both programs are comprehensive one week "leadership action programs" in state and local government for qualified high school rising seniors. It is held at Valdosta State University during the week of June 8-14.

The two programs are designed to develop a working knowledge of the structure of government and to impress upon the young citizens an understanding that the nation's government is "just what we make it."

During the week, the delegates have the opportunity to learn the political process by organizing a mythical 51st state. Each level of government is run by those delegates who are elected to serve. Instruction is presented on the law and court system, parliamentary procedure and Georgia political history.

**Boxes for the Troops Update** - - "Big" Mike Carroll, who took the responsibility for the Box program following Stephen (Steve'O) Olesnevich's death, reports that this fiscal year the Post has sent more than 275 Boxes to the Troops (July 1, 2024 – to date). Prior to his death last year Steve'O said he had mailed some 13,000 boxes to the troops during the more than 20 years that he was the mainstay for the Post's Box program.

According to an article published by Appen Media on Nov. 22, 2022, funds donated by area residents and local businesses to support the box program at that time exceeded \$100,000. Since then additional donations have pushed the total to well over \$150,000.

Big Mike said it currently costs the Post \$25 per box to mail to an APO or FPO address. He also said he is looking for volunteers to help him with packing and mailings as well as any new or updated addresses that Post members can suggest where he can send boxes.
