### **Plans for Independence Day At Post are Coming Together**

Planning for this year's Friday, July 4 Independence Day celebrations are starting to come together. However volunteers are still "desperately needed" to help marshal cars and collect a \$10 per car parking fee from those visiting the Post to celebrate the day, enjoy an evening band concert and finish the day watching the fireworks. If you can help with parking, contact Post Commander Bob Byrd as soon as possible.

The parking fee will not be charged to those who are members of the Post Family or members of other American Legion Posts (which includes SAL and Auxiliary members) and who have and present a current 2025 Legion, Auxiliary or SAL membership card. All others will be asked to pay a \$10 per car parking fee.

In addition to the historic July 4 parking demands at the Post to see the fireworks, the Highway 9 Band will also be providing music for dancing that evening in the Post ballroom. This is expected to create additional parking demands this year.

Those who are not members of the Post, but come to ‘dance’ at the Post will be asked to pay the parking fee upon entering the Post. If they identify themselves as coming to the Post to dance, they will be given a pass (one per car) which they can turn in when they enter the ballroom. That pass will allow one member of their party to pay only \$2 cash or credit as long as they turn in their pass at the reception desk. Of course, all other members of the party will be asked to pay the regular \$12 per person entrance fee.

As always, members of the area community are invited to celebrate the day and take advantage of all the Post’s facilities starting at 1 p.m. and until after the annual fireworks show at Wills Park concludes.

Here’s some additional information about activities at the Post on July 4.

- The Clubroom/Bar will open at 1 p.m. with two bartenders scheduled to be on duty. A third will be added to cover ballroom activities later in the day.
- The Auxiliary will have a 4th of July 50/50 raffle with drawing scheduled to take place prior to fireworks on the evening of the 4th. Tickets will be one for \$5, three for \$10, or 10 for \$20 - - - and you do not have to be present at the drawing to win.
- The all-volunteer Alpharetta City Band concert on the grounds is scheduled to start at 6:30 p.m.
- The baseball field concession stand will be open from 5 p.m. until 9 p.m. selling hamburgers and hotdogs. If they run out of food, then they will close earlier. The SAL will be responsible for concession stand activities this year.
- All alcoholic beverages sold on the 4th will be sold at the Clubroom/Bar. Members of the community and guests of the Post are welcome in the Clubroom/Bar all day and until after the fireworks show.

For those who might not be familiar with the Post’s safety and beverage rules, alcoholic beverages may not be brought onto the Post’s grounds. Consumer fireworks, charcoal grills and small propane grills are also prohibited on Post grounds.

The Wills Park fireworks, which can be seen from the Post’s Walk of Memories and baseball field, are scheduled to start when the sky is dark, which should be in the 9:30 p.m. time frame.
