Veterans Support Experts Available to Assist Vets With VA-Related Questions At Post's Upcoming OSD

Veterans who may have questions about how to access various VA benefits which they may be interested in applying for will have an opportunity to 'Ask the Experts' about their individual situations during Old Soldiers Day (OSD) at Post 201.

This includes questions about the paperwork they will need to have or actions they may need to take to assure that "all the boxes are correctly checked" when making the formal ask, and what they need to know or information they need to leave for their survivors if interested in being interred at a national cemetery.

Representatives from the National Cemetery in Canton, and from the Georgia Department of Veterans Services will be on hand to meet with veterans on a 1-to-1, first come-first served basis between 1 p.m. and 4 p.m. Saturday, Aug. 2 in the Post ballroom. They will be provide individualized guidance and make resource assistance recommendations so individual vets can be well-prepared when it's time to 'file the paperwork'.

At 4 p.m. there will be a showing of the Atlanta Vietnam Veterans Business Association Foundation's 47-minute documentary "Truths and Myths about The Vietnam War." Post 201 member Jim Dickson, who is chairman of the film committee which produced the documentary, will introduce it and answer audience questions about its production following the showing. The film will also be previewed at two showings at the American Legion's Aug. 22-28 national conference in Tampa Bay, Fla.

Also, members of the Legion, Auxiliary and SAL who would like to renew their membership for 2026 will be able to take care that of that between 1 p.m. and 4 p.m. at the appropriate organization's table in the ballroom. Area veterans who are not members of the American Legion, or who may be members of another Post and are interested in transferring to Post 201 will also be accommodated and new member applications for the SAL and Auxiliary will also be accepted.

OSD activities will open at 10 a.m. with a concert on the lawn provided by the Alpharetta City Band Brass Ensemble. Post leadership will hold a brief ceremony honoring the day starting at 10:30 a.m. The Post's Clubroom/Bar will open at 11 a.m. and will be offering (for those who either need - - - or want it) Bloody Mary specials all day at a reduced price.

The Post's newly refinished outdoor bar-b-que pit and grill will be put to the test starting at 12 noon. Although the menu is still being finalized, according to the event planning chair Ralph Jordan, food will be available for sale from 12 noon until it is all consumed.

All OSD activities at the Post between 10 a.m. and 6 p.m. will be open to the general public.

Tennessee Legion Post Suspended for 6 Months

American Legion Post 95 in East Ridge, Tenn. has had its charter to operate suspended for a minimum of six months by the American Legion Department of Tennessee. In a July 9, 2025 letter from Department Commander Todd McKinley to members of the Post, McKinley said the Post "has or has been known to have gaming events . . . which violates Tennessee's Gaming Laws." He also noted that the Post "failed to meet its obligations imposed by State Law and Statue as well as the Department Constitution and Bylaws . . ."

Post 201 Judge Advocate Jim Davis, in his discussion and briefing paper he presented about the Tennessee Post's suspension at Monday night's Post 201 Special Executive Committee meeting noted the following:

Tennessee Post 95's Infractions

- Failure to check current Membership status of Post/SAL/Aux Members
- Improper "sponsorship" of Guests
- Drinking during Meetings
- Intoxicated Members in Clubroom
- Check Cashing, Credit, Loans in Clubroom
- Illegal Gaming activities on premises (e.g., Ace of Diamonds)
- No State License for permissible games of chance
- No disciplinary actions for destruction of Post property

Davis also outlined some areas which he recommended that Post 201 focus on. They included:

- Ensure all Guests are logged and that the "sponsor" remains until they leave
- Remind the Membership that our Members are responsible for the conduct of their Guests and may face disciplinary action for their misconduct
- Remind all Clubroom Staff and Officers that they are empowered to ask intoxicated and/or unruly Members and Guests to leave the premises
- Continue to conduct and document all Roll-the-Dice and other Raffles in accordance with State and County regulations
- Continue to use our (Post 201) Code of Conduct to address significant violations thereof and update it accordingly
