Alpharetta Rotary Club To Provide Meal Service For Tuesday's General Membership Meeting

Members of the Post can look forward to a special treat at next Tuesday's General Membership Meeting. The Alpharetta Rotary Club will be preparing the evening meal served prior to the meeting.

In addition to the meal prep, there will also be a social meet-and-greet in the Clubroom starting at 5 p.m. so members of Post can meet members of the Rotary Club. The Rotarians are also preparing appetizers which will be available during the social hour.

Before the Post's phone line is overwhelmed with calls wanting to know what will be on the dinner menu, here's the advance information provided to the Post by Rotarian Donna Murphy: four separate appetizers, pulled pork and chicken for the main course, four side dishes as yet to be named, salad, and four dessert choices (two chocolate and two non-chocolate).

There are no "burning matters" on Tuesday night's meeting agenda, however members can expect to be updated on plans for Labor Day at the Post, Monday, Sept. 1 and take action on the routine business matters that normally come before the membership.

Labor Day Plans at Post

Based on discussions at Tuesday night's executive committee meeting the general outline for Labor Day at the Post this year assumes the following:

- The Post's Cubroom/Bar will open at 1 p.m. rather than the normal 3 p.m. opening time for Mondays.
- Activities will be focused on members of the Post 201 Family and guests whom they might want to invite
 to accompany them to the Post. Unlike some prior years, the Post will not hold a general "Open House" for
 members of the local community.
- Post Commander Bob Byrd plans to purchase a '100-pound whole hog' which will be bar-b-cued at the Post and served southern style. For those not in the know, that's a pig pickin' (also known as rolling a pig, pig pull, hog roast, pig roast or, among the Cajun set, "cochon de lait").
- Bob has also announced he'll prepare the accompanying coleslaw "the Eastern North Carolina
 way." <u>Check out this recipe</u> if you've never heard of Eastern North Carolina coleslaw. And "yes" it is
 different than Western North Carolina coleslaw.
- There will be no charge for the Labor Day meal. However, if members of the Post Family would like to bring side dishes to enhance the offerings you're more than welcome to do so.
- Food service is expected to start in the 3 p.m. time frame.
- Last, but certainly not least, members of the Post Family will be able to pay their 2026 membership dues during a 1 p.m. to 4 p.m. (more or less) window of time. And guests interested in joining the Post 201 Family may also pick up and complete the appropriate application forms.

Now, there is **ONE BIG CATCH** to the Post's Labor Day plans. **Volunteers are needed to help make the day happen.**

Specifically volunteers are needed to help with pig smoking as well as all the other assorted details which include cooking and kitchen support, labor to put up and take down tables at the beginning end of the day, and of course the absolutely necessary 'clean up' crew (those who are willing to continue working when everybody else starts disappearing!).
