### Paint Recycling Fundraiser Set for Saturday, Sept. 27

Scout Troop 51, which is sponsored by the Post, has scheduled their annual paint Recycling Fundraiser for Saturday, Sept. 27 from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. They will be set up in the Post's parking lot and will be prepared to accept all latex and oil based paints regardless of size including pints, quarts, spray cans, etc.

Help support Troop 51 by bringing your leftover cans of latex and oil-based paints to be properly disposed of or reused. Donated paint will be filtered and turned into quality, re-usable paint products and then donated back to nonprofit groups in the community such as Habitat for

Humanity, Salvation Army, and Boys & Girls Clubs. The donation cost is: 5 gallon cans - \$25 each; one gallon cans - \$5 each; quarts - \$2 each; pints - \$2 each; and spray cans - \$2 each.

A little background for those interested: The U.S. Labor Day holiday is rooted in the late nineteenth century when labor activists pushed for a federal holiday to recognize the many contributions workers made to America's strength, prosperity, and well-being.

Editor's Note: Richard "Dick" Rutan (1938–2024) was a decorated American military aviator, record-setting test pilot. He is best known for piloting the Voyager aircraft on the first nonstop, non-refueled flight around the world in 1986. As a USAF fighter pilot during the Vietnam War, he flew 325 combat missions, including 105 as part of the elite "Misty" special unit. His military honors include the Silver Star, five Distinguished Flying Crosses, 16 Air Medals, and a Purple Heart. In 2002, Rutan was inducted into the National Aviation Hall of Fame.
