### Planned Chili Cook-Off For Army-Navy Game Saturday is a 'Maybe'

Current planning calls for all chili entries to be in place by 2:30 p.m. with judging set for 3 p.m. - - 30 minutes prior to the Army-Navy game's 3:30 p.m. kick off.

However as of 6 p.m. last night, the signup sheet had only one name on it, and it wasn't for chili; it was for a side dish!

The idea of doing a chili cook-off was a suggestion made by a number of members who tend to "hang" at the bar and offer views and opinions on a variety of matters. And needless to say, the chili cook-off was a good idea. But surprisingly - - - or maybe not so surprising - - - the names of many suggesting the chili cook-off have yet to appear on the sign-up sheet as bringing something to the party.
