**Toys for Tots Update** - - This year's U.S. Marine Corps Reserve Toys for Tots campaign at the Post collected more than 20 boxes of toys, books and other gifts. This represents in excess of 500 individual gifts for less fortunate children whose parents could not afford to buy them gifts for Christmas. In addition to the gifts, 94 bicycles were donated by Gina Watson and Mike McElroy. Their donation continues a tradition they started five years ago.

Toys for Tots was founded in 1947 as the brain child of Marine Corps Reserve Major Bill Hendricks. Although, actually it was his wife, Diane, who was the real inspiration. She had a few handcrafted dolls and asked him to deliver them to an agency that supported children in need.

When he told her that he could not find such an organization she instructed him to "start one!". That year Maj Hendricks and the Marines in his reserve unit in Los Angeles collected and distributed 5,000 toys. Since those humble beginnings in 1947 (which is the same year Post 201 was organized), the Toys for Tots organization has distributed 708 million toys to 314 million children.

**Ugly Sweater & 12-Spirits Raffle** - - Thirty-plus members of the Post 201 Family dropped by the Post this past Sunday evening to enjoy the Ugly Sweater Contest, sample some tasty appetizers, and see who won the 12-Spirits raffle which raised \$460 for the Post.

SAL member Matt Gill took the Ugly Sweater honors for 2025, earning a trophy for efforts. Fellow SAL member Tom Davis won the 12-Spirits raffle, taking home a liquor basket containing Bombay Gin, Captain Morgan, Glenlivet,
