# Happy New Year

The Post's Clubroom/Bar will open at 3 p.m. today. A donated 10 ½ pound spiral ham will be available in the Clubroom for complimentary snacking when the Clubroom opens. Side dishes or appetizers would be welcomed if members of the Post Family would like to bring something to share. Today's complimentary food service will conclude when everything has been consumed.

Members of the Post Family visiting the Clubroom today will also find that bartenders will be asking to see your 2026 membership card. This ask is being made of members of all units of the Post 201 Family.

If you haven't renewed your membership for calendar year 2026, your 2025 membership card will still be accepted for member-priced drinks. This grace period to get your membership updated will last until the end of January.

Also effective today, patrons who pay their bar tabs using a credit or debit card will see a card processing fee added to the invoice. A recent review of the Post's card processing fees (which the Post was not passing through to card users) showed that the average monthly cost for the Post to subsidize card users is costing the Post \$1,400-plus every month.

Sales taxes for drinks at the Post are already included in the individual price structure for each drink (which are far

less than comparable prices at most other establishments), but card processing fees, which have been gradually increasing over the years, were not considered when the last major review of drink prices were conducted.
