**General Membership Meeting** - - The Post's first General Membership meeting for calendar year 2026 is scheduled for 7 p.m. next Tuesday. As usual, a complimentary meal will be available starting in the 6 p.m. time frame. At publication deadline, the menu had not been determined. And just a hint: don't be too surprised if there's a spot check for 2026 membership cards at the beginning of the line.

Also, during the meeting itself, the general membership will be asked to approve a dues increase for Legion members

of Post 201 to \$50 per year for the 2027 calendar year/membership year. There is every expectation that the national organization may increase their dues for the same membership year. However, the Post must make its decision prior to knowing what National will do. Currently from each \$40 membership at Post 201, the Post keeps \$5, National gets \$23, and the remaining \$12 goes to the Department of Georgia for its operation as well as supporting the Districts in the state.

**SAL Plans 2 Food Functions** - - The SAL is planning to put complimentary food out in the clubroom on Sunday, Jan. 25 in the 4:30 p.m. timeframe. It will be pizza and finger foods for the NFC and AFC Championship games that are held that afternoon and evening.
