Weather Forecast Closes Post Saturday Afternoon, Sunday, Monday; Will Reopen Tuesday

Due to the expected inclement weather this weekend, Post Commander Bob Byrd announced yesterday afternoon that the Post will close midday Saturday, immediately after the Oratorical Contest is completed. The contest is scheduled to start at 10 a.m. and is expected to draw to a close in the 12 noon time frame.

The Post will remain closed for the remainder of day on Saturday, as well as Sunday and Monday. It will reopen for regular business Tuesday.

The closure means Bingo this Sunday is also cancelled, with the next Bingo at the Post scheduled for 2 p.m. Sunday, Feb. 8. Also there will be no dance activities at the Post Saturday and Sunday night as well as Monday morning's dance class.

SAL's Sunday afternoon complimentary pizza and finger foods watch party for the NFC and AFC Championship games being played that day will be rescheduled in conjunction with another sporting event at a later date, said SAL Commander Derek Garmon.

Post 201's Oratorical Contest Still Set for 10 a.m. Saturday

Although the weather is expected to start turning rather unpleasant sometime mid-to-late afternoon Saturday, the

Post's Oratorical Contest is still on tap for 10 a.m. Saturday morning in the Post's Ballroom.

Each of the four contestants, all active high school students in grades 9 to 12, are preparing 8-to-10 minute presentations on some aspect of the U.S. Constitution, with an emphasis on the duties and obligations of citizens to the nation's government.

In addition to the prepared presentation, each contestant must also be ready to provide a second, three-to-five minute presentation on an 'unannounced in advance topic' from one of the following four amendments to the Constitution

- Amendment IV – Rights against unreasonable searches and seizures
- Article III Section 3 – Treason against the United States
- Article IV Section 4 – Guarantees States a Republican Form of Government and protection against invasion
- Article VI Clause 3 – States shall be bound to support the Constitution

The top three winners in the competition will be awarded the following prizes: 1st Place - \$1,000; 2nd place - \$750; and 3rd place - \$500.

The winner of the Post's competition will advance to the next level, with the winner at each level moving to the next higher level and ultimately the national competition. Those competition dates are: District 9 - TBD but no later than March 1; Area 3 - TBD but no later than March 15; Department of Georgia – 2 p.m. Sunday, March 29 at Mary Persons Auditorium in Forsyth, Ga.; and the national finals - May 15 – 17 at Hillsdale College in Hillsdale, Mich.

Additional scholarship money is earned at each level of competition. The national competition winner's earnings will be in the range of \$25,000 in scholarship awards.
