ALPHARETTA AMERICAN LEGION POST 201 INVITES PUBLIC TO ITS 9/11 REMEMBRANCE CEREMONY

A solemn ceremony remembering the victims and heroes of the terrorist attack on America that killed nearly 3,000 people on September 11, 2001, will take place on the 25th anniversary of the worst terrorist attack on America since Pearl Harbor.

The ceremony starting at 9 a.m. on Friday, September 11th on the Post's Walk of Memories will include placing the first memorial brick in a new section of the Walk shaped like a Pentagon. The brick will serve to honor and remember the 16 individuals with connections to Georgia who died that day at the World Trade Center and Pentagon. Among them, Roswell resident Michael Gann who perished at the World Trade Center as terrorists attacked our homeland.

Retired U.S Navy SEAL Nicholas Bellenbaum will be guest speaker for the Patriot Day event. Music will be provided by the Alpha Brass, part of the Alpharetta City Band, as well as by members of the Innovation Academy Chorus.

Bellenbaum retired from the Navy in 2019 after more than 20 years of service. Most of his military service was as a Navy SEAL with multiple operational deployments with SEAL Teams 1, 2, and 8 as well as service with the Naval Special Warfare Training Command.

The Post will observe a moment of Silence on the 11th at the time each of the four hijacked jetliners crashed. Of the 2,977 killed 415 were first responders.

The Post is located at 201 Wills Road in Alpharetta.

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
